**PICKING SIDES is NORMAL.**

**ELIMINATING SIDES is WEIRD.**

***How do we handle it when two believers disagree?***

FROM THE OUTSIDE LOOKING IN:

- ❖ **REFUSE** to take **SIDES**.
- ❖ Get our **HEARTS** in the right **PLACE**.
- ❖ **AFFIRM** the **CALLING** of both parties.

FROM THE INSIDE LOOKING OUT:

- ❖ **RIGHT-SIZE** the **SITUATION**.  
“Satan thrives on conflict and he wants you in conflict.” -*Dr. Richard J. Krejcir*
- ❖ **RECOGNIZE** the other party’s God-given **GIFTS**.  
“There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work.” -*1 Corinthians 12:4-6*
- ❖ Set aside **PRIDE** in favor of **GRACE**.
